Who do you contact for assistance with stray dogs/cats in the community? James City County Animal Control is available for assistance. Call 757-565-0370 and Shirley Anderson, Animal Control Supervisor or one of her staff members will help!

The divisions mission is to serve the community on topics involving the welfare of animals as well as to assist with problem, neglected and dangerous animals.

Report stray pets or abuse

Call 757-565-0370 to report stray dogs and cats, suspected abuse of livestock or domestic animals and small injured wildlife such as raccoons and opossums.

Request Removal of Dead Animals Along Roadways

For the removal of dead animals along roadways, contact the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) by reporting a road problem online or calling 1-800-FOR-ROAD (1-800-367-7623).

Report Problems with Wildlife

Call the <u>Department of Game and Inland Fisheries</u> at 804-829-6580 or 855-571-9003 for nuisance wildlife or to report problems with larger wildlife such as bears or deer.
